



Dear Legislator,

We are a group of leading Second Amendment experts, public safety advocates, and citizens who are concerned about our firearms rights and liberties. We are also concerned about public safety, personal and family safety, and the erosion of our individual liberty. We support the full repeal of Colorado's 2013 legislative ban on magazine capacity.

The 2013 15-round magazine limitations have made us less safe. As legislators, you can be on the leading edge of restoring safety for responsible, law-abiding Colorado families by allowing them to choose, once again, their own self-defense. Public and private safety and individual liberty demand we have our full rights restored.

If —due to the political climate— full repeal doesn't happen this year, we need a realistic, step-by-step path to full repeal. The courageous lawmakers in Ohio did just that with help from the Buckeye Firearms Association. Ohioans now enjoy full repeal because they fought for every small victory along the way. It's simple: one step towards full repeal is better for Colorado families than no steps at all.

Committed conservative organizations in our state all want to end up in the same place: full repeal of unnecessary, ineffective, prohibitive firearms restrictions. But an all or nothing strategy that dismisses the re-legalization of 30-round magazines leaves us with nothing. "Nothing" is not the "moral high ground" as some have suggested. Instead, it plays politics with our Second Amendment rights, and we won't stand for that.

Re-legalization of 30-round magazines would make a meaningful difference for Colorado families. We can't allow politics to get in the way. We are shocked that anyone would suggest that such a change would be equivalent to "compromise." Beginning to roll back restrictions —on the way to full repeal— would be a sound victory for Colorado gun owners and a ringing defeat for the gun control lobby.

We look forward to working with you to re-legalize 30-round magazines. For those who work with us, ***we will have your back.***
