



Dear Legislator,

We are a group of women who advocate for a full repeal of Colorado's 2013 legislative ban on standard capacity magazines. On our way to full repeal, we also support an important incremental step – the re-legalization of 30-round magazines – like courageous lawmakers did in Ohio with help from the Buckeye Firearms Association. Ohioans now enjoy full repeal because they fought for every small victory along the way.

Women have become a growing force in the gun rights movement because for us a firearm is the great equalizer. A firearm may be the only thing standing between us and bodily harm — including sexual assault. Law enforcement cannot be with us 24/7 for protection, but our firearm with a 17 or 30 round magazine can. We cannot afford to wait until the political stars are in perfect alignment to hope for a full repeal. Our lives and safety may well rest upon you doing the right thing and re-legalizing 30 round magazines.

What is the political price for a woman to feel safe and secure, confident that she can protect herself and her family?

We will be very clear. Full repeal is our ultimate goal, but an all or nothing strategy, that dismisses the re-legalization of 30 round magazines, leaves the most vulnerable among us with nothing. “Nothing” is not the “moral high ground” as some have suggested. Instead, it plays politics with our choice in self-defense.

We look forward to working with you to re-legalize 30 round magazines. For those who work with us, ***we will have your back.***
